## THE CREST

The Crest of the National Defence College illustrates seven features as explained below;

### **Blue Water Lily**

Blue Water Lily is the national flower of Sri Lanka. This plant grows in clear or muddy ponds, yet the flower blooms above the water surface with equal beauty and scent irrespective of the medium in which it grows. It does not acquire the characteristics of the medium, nor accumulate any dirt; the flower remains pure and beautiful irrespective of external factors. Therefore, Blue Water Lily petals around the shield identify the college's purity and ability to produce future leaders who can excel and drive the nation towards prosperity, irrespective of where they come from. The petals represent the 25 administrative districts of Sri Lanka.

#### **Ancient Shield**

The shield represents defence and security from any external or internal threats which is the combined responsibility of Army, Navy, Air Force, Police, Ministries and Departments of the government and every citizen of the state. Therefore, the Bronze Shield identifies the defence and security of the state and its territorial integrity. The 9 tags on the shield represent the 9 provinces of Sri Lanka. The colour bronze represents the ancient history and survival of the state.

#### **National Emblem**

The National Emblem represents the representative democracy of Sri Lanka as clearly enshrined in the Constitution of the Republic. The National Emblem placed at the crown of the logo represents the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as a free and independent state with a representative democracy at its core. The college holds national values as supreme and serves towards preparing leaders and decision-makers for the state.



#### **Two Sheaves of Paddy**

Two sheaves of paddy represent prosperity and well-being of the nation in social and economic aspects. Placement of them upon the shield denotes the commitment of the college towards achieving and sustaining prosperity with resilience.

#### Lamp


Lamp in the center represents the shedding of ignorance and attaining wisdom with positivity and goodness. The college contributes to generate wisdom among leaders and decision-makers that will pave the way for prosperity with resilience.

#### The Scroll (placed below the shield)

It carries the motto of the college 'Wisdom Prosperity Resilience' displaying the vision and objectives in a nutshell.

#### The Scroll (placed on the shield)

It carries the words 'National Defence College' introducing the college to everyone.



National Defence College has been inaugurated as the premier strategic education establishment in Sri Lanka to develop future policy-makers in the realm of national security, statecraft, governance, diplomacy and international security to strengthen the national security mechanism in the country through collective intellectual rigour. The NDC was inaugurated on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2021 by His Excellency the President of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces and Minister of Defence, Gotabaya Rajapaksa.

The NDC provides high-quality professional strategic education to produce graduates who are skilled in critical strategic thinking that facilitates them to provide professional counsel in achieving national security objectives. The NDC will also usher in a new era to enhance the professionalism of the Armed Forces, Police and the public sector. It will seek to foster inter-institutional civil-military synergy to strengthen the national security mechanism of the state through intellectual endeavor. The NDC is affiliated to the General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University, Sri Lanka for the award of postgraduate degrees. The NDC is a platform to bring all officials at the highest level to study issues pertaining to National Security, thus creating a joint environment for civil-military cooperation. The degrees will aim at creating strategic analysts, thinkers, strategic strategic decision-makers and strategic advisors. Therefore, it is a mandatory requirement to provide the best possible higher-level politico-military strategic exposure and post graduate degree programmes (MSc/ MPhil) related to the subjects of National Security, Strategy and Policy to enable NDC to achieve international standards.

The National Security and Strategic Studies Course is a multi-disciplinary learning platform tailored to suit the stated objective. A total of eight study modules are spread over two semesters; each module is developed considering the formulation of strategic options for decision-making with respect to current national, regional and global issues/ scenarios that affect national security and policy. Further, course participants have the opportunity to meet state leaders and policy-makers locally and internationally to broaden their understanding on the concept of national security. The National Defence College began its journey seven years ago as the most prestigious institution for gaining advanced knowledge on national security and strategy for senior officials in the armed forces, the Police and the public sector.

EVOLUTION OF

In 2015, Major General Anton Wijendra submitted a proposal on the need for the establishment of the National Defence College in Sri Lanka. Subsequently, there had been several boards comprised of officers from armed forces, appointed to study the feasibility of establishing a NDC in Sri Lanka. Based on the reports submitted, a cabinet memorandum was tabled to establish the NDC at Mumtaz Mahal which was used as speaker's residence between 1948 - 2001. Cabinet approval was granted on 07<sup>th</sup> December 2016 to establish the NDC at Mumtaz Mahal and to explore the possibility of obtaining concessionary funding for the purpose.

However, due to financial constraints, renovation of Mumtaz Mahal building was delayed till the latter part of 2018 up until the funding of Rs. 20 million by the Ministry of Defence and provision of necessary work teams by armed forces. Mihindu Vidyalaya, Dehiwala which was an abandoned school building had become the administrative base for the NDC to house skeleton staff appointed by the armed forces.

During the process, armed forces had taken a remarkable effort in preserving the old architectural elements of the Mumtaz Mahal, the historical building in which the NDC commenced its journey. Assistance from several friendly states facilitated the NDC to add several important features. The People's Republic of China constructed a state-ofthe-art auditorium whilst the Islamic Republic of Pakistan provided the infrastructure and other necessary equipment to set up the much-needed library. The Australian Department of Defence has donated over 600 books covering subjects related to international relations, security, strategy and policy, etc. The Road Development Authority has also assisted in developing the premises.

To formulate a sophisticated study curriculum, the Australian Department of Defence had assigned Captain Andrew Deakin for the Curriculum Development Board comprised of the officers from armed forces who drafted the initial subject modules with relevant inputs from the officers who had completed similar NDC qualifications from accredited institutions.

At the outset, administrators felt that an affiliation with a recognized university was a necessity to gain much needed credibility to the NDC. Therefore, the college reached out to a few leading universities, such as the University of Colombo (UoC) and the General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University (KDU). It was finally decided to affiliate the NDC with the KDU, to award post graduate degrees.

From its humble beginning way back in 2016, the National Defence College was ceremoniously declared open by His Excellency Gotabaya Rajapaksa, the President and Commander-in-Chief of the armed forces in Sri Lanka, on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2021.







## **SEMESTER ONE**

In the wake of the colourful inauguration of the NDC, participants joined the college on 09<sup>th</sup> January 2023 to commence the academic journey. The opening address by the Commandant NDC provided an adequate insight and added weightage to the upcoming challenges of the course. The first capsule was the Introduction to Strategy and Policy. The main objective of the module was to stimulate strategic thinking in senior military/police officers to grapple with the complex interrelationship among policy, grand strategy and strategy that span in peace-war situations.

The Exercise 'MASTER MIND', a major strategic planning exercise related to the Sri Lankan context, covering aspects of contemporary issues was conducted as a part of the National Security and Strategic Study (NS&SS) course curriculum.

Final module of the first semester was the science and technology module which was aimed at identifying the impacts of science and technology on society and national security.

During the first semester, course participants were taken on various research visits to Colombo National Museum, department of National Archives, Sri Lanka Ports Authority, Colombo Dockyard, CHEC Port City Colombo, Bandaranaike International Airport and Sri Lanka Air Force, Base, Katunayake. Apart from the academic and social activities, course participants and their spouses got a golden opportunity to have an excursion to Trincomalee Naval Base during the latter part of the semester. During the visit, participants were able to visit the Naval Museum, Pigeon Island, Nilaweli Beach. In addition, course participants were taken on a number of local study visits.



# **SEMESTER TWO**

he second semester commenced on 04<sup>th</sup> July 2023 with the International Security module. The module examines; the sources of international security, global regional conflicts, statecraft, conflicts. crisis management, and regional security, complex security issues that exist along the continuum between war and peace. Further, analysis on the dynamics of international security environment, shaping of national security strategies, current and emerging transnational as well as regional security threats, challenges from international actors and international influences on the formulation of regional and national security strategies.

The second module of the semester was Geopolitics and Strategy which had a focus on the understanding of geo-strategic perspectives with respect to national, regional and global contexts over different aspects of critical importance to national security. An interactive process to conduct a critical analysis of local, regional and global strategic issues, changes in the post-WWII world political order and understand its impact on national interest and national security was included in this module.

NDC concluded the International Collaborative Study Package which was scheduled as per the annual course curriculum. The study package comprised of two delegations to India and Pakistan. The aim of the visits was to gain strategic exposure and insight on both the countries higher levels with selected Ministries and Institutions by senior officers of Tri - Services and Police as the future leaders in respective services. During the visit both the delegations had opportunities to have cordial discussions on matters on mutual interests in the regional and global security interests.

The final module of the second semester was National Security and Policy. The main

objective of this module was to offer a theoretical and conceptual understanding of major strategic issues under discussion, to make the students aware of National Defence/Security from a theoretical and conceptual framework, to critically examine existing national security structures and miscellaneous factors and to provide an opportunity to construct national security policy by analysing threats, strengths, vulnerabilities and opportunities. During this module, course participants were able to broaden their horizons on the subject by interacting with eminent scholars and expertise including the Secretary to the Ministry of Defence and Commanders of armed forces of Sri Lanka.












# **FACILITIES AT NDC**
